Nextbike is a designer, manufacturer, supplier and operator of public bike hire schemes. Founded in Leipzig, Germany in 2004, the company has grown rapidly from a small bike hire scheme with 20 bikes to a truly global operation with schemes in nearly 300 cities across 26 countries worldwide and over 90,000 bikes. Nextbikers all share a common goal: to change the cityscape across the United Kingdom and the world.

Our Cardiff and Vale of Glamorgan scheme (sponsored by OVO) includes over 1000 bikes (pedal and electric) across more than 100 docking stations in Cardiff and the Vale of Glamorgan. We recently expanded the e-bike fleet from 50 to 100 e-bikes, launching new electric stations in Cardiff after initially starting with the Vale.

We are looking for an energetic Mechanic to help maintain our bikes and ensure they are safe and ready for distribution.

- Undertake regular servicing of all nextbikes and electric assist nextbikes, update records and ensure bikes are safe and fit for public use.
- Maintain onboard computers.
- Report all vandalised and damaged bikes.
- Support charging system for bikes.
- Support the redistribution of bikes, station inspections and bike charging.
- Keep accurate records of stock levels.
